Will there be any left for me?



ACTIVITY

Fishing Game

YOU WILL NEED

- A large box
- Thin card
- Scissors and Ruler
- Glue
- Blue Paint
- Sticky Tape
- Felt Pens
- Sticks
- String
- Paper Clips

METHOD

- 1 Mark a line 5 cm from the end on your box. Cut along this line. You now have a shallow lake. Paint your lake blue.
- 2 Draw some fish, starfish and shells on thin card. Cut them out and colour them with felt pens. Repeat this several times until you have plenty fish, starfish and shells.
- 3 Fold up a section of each paper clip and attach it with sticky tape to the mouth of each fish, starfish and shell.
- 4 Make a rod for each player. To make a rod, tie a piece of string to one end of each stick. Now tie a paper clip to the end of each piece of string. Open the paper clips and shape them into hooks. Now you are ready to fish.

DIFFERENT VARIATIONS OF THE GAME

- Give each fish a weight value – adding the values at the end of the game to see which “catch” is worth the most.

DIFFERENT VARIATIONS OF THE GAME

- Write a fishy question on each fish. The person who catches the fish must answer the question to retain the fish – otherwise it is returned to the lake.
